

# Mrs. Liebl---High School Study Hall Rules

## **Study Hall: (information from student handbook)**

Study Hall The purpose of the Study Hall is to provide a student with the opportunity to do class assignments. If it appears that students have nothing to do in Study Halls, teachers will be asked to give more outside assignments. Students should check with each study hall teacher for specific policies for that hour. Some general guidelines to follow when entering all study halls include: 1. Immediately proceed and sit in assigned seat. 2. Talk only when permission is granted by the study hall teacher. 3. Use time to study and complete assignments. 4. Have passes signed before arriving at the study hall. 5. Sign in and out each time leaving and returning to the study hall. This includes student's name, where student is going and the time student left and returned. 6. Electronic devices may be used for individual reading or music with approval of the study hall supervisor. Students on the ineligible list will not be allowed to use electronic devices. 7. No playing cards or games during study hall. If for some reason a student misuses their study hall privileges, the study hall teacher has the option of discontinuing privileges for that student.

## **Mrs. Liebl Study Hall rules:**

1. Computer use will be monitored at all times.
2. No YouTube videos, Netflix, or watching movies/tv shows.
3. No game playing the entire period (last 5 minutes of the period is okay).
4. Free Study Students only--Juniors and Seniors must check into study hall at the beginning of the period. Let Mrs. Liebl know you are here.
5. Be in assigned seat when bell rings.
6. Bring enough work with you for the entire period. Bring work and reading materials daily.
7. Students may listen to music but must use headphones.
8. Students may talk quietly without permission. Limit of two people talking at one time. Limit talk time to 3-4 minutes.
9. Use time to study and complete assignments.
10. Have pink passes from teachers signed before arriving to study hall.
11. Laminated Passes for bathroom/locker/library/office—we will use laminated passes, two passes will be used for all students. No student may leave study hall without a pass! Only one student per pass.
  - a. Checkout sheet will be available in the room on a clipboard. Students may go to the restroom, lockers, water fountain, office, etc. Students can be checked out for **4-5 minutes only**. Sign in and out each time leaving and returning to the study hall. If you abuse the checkout time period, your privileges will be revoked. Check out time is not to be used for cell phone use.
  - b. Use the bathrooms in the high school hallway only. You do not need to use the bathrooms in the elementary or old gym.
  - c. **Be sure if you check out, you must return before period is over.**
12. No loitering in the hallways or gyms.
13. Computer use will be monitored. Please remember that computer use is intended for classroom assignments and projects. If inappropriate computer use (playing games all period) becomes a problem, then privileges will be taken away.
